

## ***Delineation. Drawing Environmental Boundaries.***

**EAEH, Friday, 29th June, 2007**

The aim of this meeting is to examine the way in which boundaries, in the widest sense, are set within environmental history. It could include; the occurrence of physical and conceptual boundaries in the landscape, how the importance of some (types of) boundaries is asserted, and how some issues are defined as falling within “environmental history”. Topics could reach from the broad sweep of climate zones to the details of landscape character assessments. Papers could also consider how people define the boundaries both within, and of, the environment, both as a “place” and a set of issues.
